



Information on Covid-19 regulations in Graz during the Diagonale'21

(as of May 24, 2021)

General rules:

- Keep a distance of at least 2 meters to all people who do not live in the same household
- Compliance with the hygiene rules (please observe all instructions)
- Wearing a FFP2-mask (without exhalation valve) – wherever the minimum distance could be exceeded, or indoors, as well as at the assigned seats at all events
- Closing hour is at 10 p.m. (at all venues as well as in all bars, restaurants, ...)
- Please note: **No admission after the start of the event or screening!**
- Mandatory registration for all events and screenings
- Between visitors at least one seat must be left empty; the capacity of event locations with fixed seating must not be booked at a rate of more than 50 %

According to the regulation of the Ministry of Health (Covid-19-ÖV), entry to the venues of Diagonale'21 is only possible for tested, vaccinated or recovered persons. The following applies as proof:

TESTED

Proof of a negative COVID-19 test result through

- an officially registered antigen test for personal use that is **no older than 24 hours**
- an authorized antigen test **no older than 48 hours**
- an authorized PCR test **no older than 72 hours**

VACCINATED

(with a centrally approved vaccine against Covid-19)

- First vaccination from the 22nd day after the first vaccination, whereby this must not be more than three months ago
- Second vaccination, whereby the first vaccination must not be more than nine months ago
- In the case of vaccines for which only one vaccination is scheduled, from the 22nd day after vaccination

RECOVERED

- Medical confirmation of an infection with SARS-CoV-2 that has been overcome in the last **six months**, which has been confirmed moleculobiologically.
- Antibody detection, which must **not be older than 3 months**

- The curfew for restaurants and venues applies between 10 pm and 5 am
- During all Diagonale'21 events the venues are allocated in a chessboard pattern up to a maximum capacity of 50 percent.
- Please note: **No admission after the start of the event!**
- For all events, registration is mandatory for the participating persons in the course of contact data management.

Information on the current entry requirements to Austria

(as of May 19, 2021)

Guests of the Diagonale who arrive from abroad are required to inform themselves about the corresponding entry regulations for Austria and the return travel regulations of their country of origin and to behave accordingly.



- **a pre-travel clearance has to be filled out before entry Registration may take place at the earliest 72 hours before entering Austria. You can find the form here:**

- **a proof in terms of the so-called 3G regulation must be provided (for countries without quarantine)
= negative Covid test, valid vaccination or proof of recovery;**

If no negative proof can be provided on entry, this must be provided within 24 hours of entry by means of a PCR or antigen test.

From June 1, entry into Austria from countries with a correspondingly low incidence will be possible without quarantine. Countries without quarantine are:

In Europe:

Andorra, Australia, Belgium, Bulgaria, Croatia, Cyprus, Czech Republic, Denmark, Estonia, Finland, France, Germany, Greece, Hungary, Iceland, Ireland, Israel, Italy, Latvia, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Malta, Monaco, Netherlands, New Zealand, Norway, Poland, Portugal, Romania, San Marino, Singapore, Slovakia, Slovenia, Spain, Switzerland, South Korea and the Vatican.

Entering Austria

Online Pre-Travel-Clearance is mandatory!
